Practical elements include creating mosaic coasters, aqueducts and bread. They will be looking at where the Roman Empire started and where it spread to using atlases. They will practise Roman marching and forming the testudo with their own hand made shields. They will focus on one mountain range (Alps or Andes) and create fact files about it and presenting them. Alongside this they will be creating the mountain range out of junk, papier mache and paint. 	Art/Computing/D&T/Geography/History/Languages/Music/PE/RE/SRE This topic will develop children's knowledge, help them understand how important this group is in the chronology of Britain. Practical elements like building model huts and longships along with looking at Viking knot artwork will take place. Children will look at the kings of the Saxon age and timeline in which they ruled.			Art/Computing/D&T/Geography/History/Languages/Music/PE/RE/SRE Introduce children to rainforests around the world. Using atlases to discover where they are situated. Discovering what they are and who lives in them. They will be looking at why the rainforests are being cut down and the difference in sizes from past to now. Practical skills such as sketching animals, collaging and creating salt dough continents which have many rainforests.			Art/Computing/D&T/Geography/History/Languages/Music/PE/RE/SRE Children will be looking at the history of sports such as cricket and the Olympic Games. They then compare and contrast the founding competitions to the modern tournaments which take place. Practical elements are playing the sports and creating graphs and charts from their results. They look at the rules and risk assessments then create their own. The children use atlases to see which countries were included in the British Empire within the subsection of cricket.
