Robins have started the new term with great enthusiasm. We celebrated St George's Day by finding out who he was and why he became a Patron Saint. We have been busy in Maths adding and taking away. We have tasted different fruits in preparation for making our own fruit salad. We were very excited to watch our eggs being candled and discovering we had chicks in all ten!



Wrens It was lovely to hear all about the Wrens Easter holidays and what they had been up to. They all did some fantastic writing about where they had been over Easter and what fun they got up to. Since returning to school the Wrens have started their new topics and been enjoying spending time in our outside area engaging in some activities linked to our classroom work. They have also been learning about money and the value of the coins and how we add them together to make a total amount. The Year 2 children also had their first Forest School session and had the opportunity to make lots of bubbles! Well done Wrens.





Skylarks In Skylarks we have been learning how to tell the time using analogue clocks. This is quite a tricky concept, especially as we see analogue clocks much less frequently than we used to. We have secured our foundation of o'clock and half past times and are recapping quarter past and quarter to along with the more challenging times to 5 mins past and to the hour! Keep practising at home everyone! In Art we have started our new unit of work entitled 'Growing Artists'. This unit focuses on drawing skills and ways in which artists using drawing media to create different effects. We have learnt how to see and draw basic shapes in a still life and then add lines and tones to bring them to life. This week we have explored texture using wax crayon rubbings, paper cutting and tearing to create our OWN compositions - you can see the children's wonderful work Dojo! And finally, Thursday, ON Skylarks started their swimming lessons at Diss pool. They did a fantastic job travelling with the year 5 children on the coach and came back full of excitement. The swimming teacher has assessed their individual swimming abilities and lessons will continue weekly on a Thursday throughout the Summer term.

Swifts A busy start to the term in Swifts, Year 6s have been working incredibly hard preparation for SATs and Year 5s have enjoyed their start Swimming. In Maths, we have begun looking at ratio, which is a pretty new concept to many of us but we have all shown a good understanding of it! In English, we have written informal postcards from fairytale villains, we have made lots of links to the fairytales and lots of subtle puns within them. In Geography we have begun looking at China, we found out it had 14 bordering countries! We are looking forward to learning more about the country - especially the Great Wall of China!
