

# LOOK what we're LEARNING


Robins have had a fantastic start to their school journey. They have made lots of new friends both inside and out of the classroom. Miss Rout and I are very proud of all the children and how well they have settled into Robins. We have begun our phonics journey, and the children are already amazing at sounding and blending and forming letters. In Maths we have been busy looking at matching items and pictures. We were all very excited for PE and were brilliant at getting changed. We finished our first full week by having a fabulous time at Forest School.

have been super settling into their new year groups and new classroom routines. They have really enjoyed starting their new Art unit and making some amazing sculptures. In maths we have been exploring 2D shapes and identifying their different properties. In English the Wrens have been working ON their handwriting and sentence structuring, making sure that they are remembering capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. They've also been developing friendships and making friends. Well done Wrens we are all very proud of the positive start you've all made!



Skylarks have had a very busy time learning all about the Stone Age. In Art we have looked at the cave paintings that have been discovered, and we have used pencil and charcoal to sketch our own images of UK animals and birds (look out on Dojo for some beautiful examples!) In Maths we have been learning how partition 3-digit numbers and use these numbers to solve problems with 1, 2or 3 steps. In English we have been very excited by the fictional mystery creature that washed up on a shore! The children have acted as newspaper reporters, collected eyewitness begun to build accounts and sentences independently to describe the fictional events.

Swifts What an amazing start to the year! Swifts have come back from the summer ready to learn and with great attitudes! The Year 5s have been coping and adapting well to life in UKS2 and the Year 6s have been wonderful role models to them, supporting them in many aspects. In Maths, there has been a lot of recap for our Year 6s looking at numbers up to 10,000,000, which is a huge jump for our 5s who are used to working with 4-digit numbers! In English, we have been creating writing based on the story The Nowhere Emporium (which is also our VIPERS book for this term), the description and imagery that has been used so far has been brilliant! We're all enjoying the book and are looking forward to what happens next!
